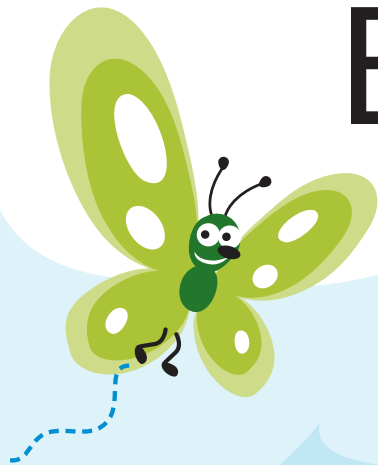

# Eye-deas

VISION-THEMED ACTIVITIES



## Goal:

Promote awareness of a child's own eyes and visual performance.

## Materials:

Items commonly available in all classrooms.

## Activities:

### Private Eye

A mystery of missing mementoes where sleuths solve a case of subtraction. Line up a number of objects. Have the children close their eyes while you remove one or more items. Can anyone identify and describe in detail what went missing? A perfect activity to promote visual memory and comparison.

### Treasure Hunt

Ahoy, mateys! Have your young pirates look near and far for buried – or at least partially hidden – treasure. Draw selected items on the blackboard and have your children look for the objects within the classroom. This treasure hunt promotes visual performance.

### Eye Spy

I spy with my little eye something that is red? Square? A game where everyone is on the lookout for your prized pick. Choose an object and make others guess what you see. A simple, but great, activity to promote visual comparison and visual performance.
