# Googley Eyes ACTIVITY

## Goal:

Create greater awareness of a child's own eyes and those of their classmates.

## Materials:

Colouring sheet (included)

## How to:

Everyone has different coloured eyes. A person's two eyes may not even be the same colour. Some eyes are even shaped differently than other people's.

Have children look in a mirror and describe what colours they see in their eyes. Or have them turn to their classmate and describe theirs. Distribute the colouring sheet and allow the children to colour the eyes to resemble their own, their classmate's or someone with out-of-this world goofy, googley eyes. This activity is a perfect opportunity to discuss how important eyes are and safety issues.
