Magic Glasses

ACTIVITY



Goal:

Create a positive and fun image of glasses.

Materials:

Cardboard, lens-free glasses (included)
Arts and craft items (included)

How to:

Have children assume an identity and create glasses to suit using available art supplies. Children can paint black spots on the supplied specs and turn into a super-sighted guide dog; glue on whiskers and become the cat's meow; or paste on glitter and take centre-stage as a Hollywood movie star. Children can also use their imagination to make magical specs that allow them to see things other people can't.

This activity is a perfect opportunity to discuss why people use glasses (i.e., to see better and/or protect eyes during work or play).



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
